CLEARY FUND – GRANT CONDITIONS

You will be informed of the outcome of your application in early October. Should your application be successful, payment of the grant will be dependent on the following:

- a) Grants cannot be offered retrospectively; work should not have already started or have been completed before applying
- b) If your application is successful, you will be sent a Grant Acceptance form and a Grant Claim form upon notification of your grant offer
- c) You should sign and return your Grant Claim form within one month of receipt to signal your acceptance of the grant
- d) Once a grant is awarded it will remain available for three years. In some cases, this period may be extended, but usually it will be necessary to re-apply for a grant if it has not been taken up within the period
- e) Payment of the grant will be made, at the discretion of the Group's officers, upon completion of the works
- f) Upon completion of the works, in order to claim your grant you will need to return your Grant Completion form along with relevant supporting documents as set out in the completion form
- g) Grant recipients must adhere strictly to the conditions of any Faculty, Listed Building Consent, or equivalent consent which was in place at the time of the grant offer to remain eligible for payment
- h) Recipients must acknowledge the Group in any publicity arising from the work
